Through volunteers and staff, PLC provides free civil legal services, including counseling, individual representation, community education, and strategic litigation and advocacy to challenge societal injustices. Now in its 37 <sup>th</sup> year of service, PLC works with more than 1,400 volunteer lawyers, paralegals and law students from throughout the county who volunteer their time and expertise.  The Consumer Unit provides assistance in the following areas: Debt Collection Defense, Bankruptcy, Student Loans, Auto Fraud, Homeownership, Elder Abuse and general Civil Litigation.
