	PLC works closely with volunteer attorneys, paralegals, law students, and others who donate their time and resources to provide free assistance for PLC's clients. PLC staff work closely with volunteers to provide technical support, training and other resources. The pro bono coordinator will work with the Pro Bono Director and PLC program staff to support the planning, delivery, and evaluation of PLC's pro bono program.
